

The University of Maine Fishing Club Official Pushaw Lake Ice Derby Rules

Feb 23rd 2019

Weigh in Location: Gould's Landing Orono, ME

Start Time: Sunrise (6:23 AM)

Last Call for Weigh in: 2:00 PM

Raffle Pull: 2:15 PM (Angler MUST be present to win raffle prize)

Legal Waters: Pushaw Lake, no further than Pushaw Dam, no further than mouth of the inlet stream

Adult Division (18 Years and older) Prizes

- Heaviest cumulative weight caught of Northern Pike (15% of earnings from entry fee)
 - o Hybrid Northern Pike and Chain Pickerel qualify for this category
- Heaviest Largemouth Bass (15% of earnings from entry fee)
- Heaviest Chain Pickerel (15% of earnings from entry fee)
- Heaviest White Perch (15% of earnings from entry fee)

Youth Division (17 Years and younger) Prizes

- Heaviest Largemouth Bass (Physical Prize TBA)
- Heaviest Chain Pickerel (Physical Prize TBA)
- Heaviest Yellow Perch (Physical Prize TBA)
- Heaviest White Perch (Physical Prize TBA)

Raffle (Adults 18 and older)

- 20% of earnings from entry fee (Extra tickets sold at weigh in)
 - o If no fish in a given category are weighed in, part of the winnings of the category will be combined with raffle prize

Alternative Prize Option (All Anglers)

- Most Black Crappie caught and brought to weigh in (Costa del mar Trucker Cap)

Rules:

- General fishing law applies. The University of Maine Fishing Club is not responsible for the breaking of Maine state law. Game Wardens will be present at the event.

- The University of Maine Fishing Club reserves the right to inspect the stomach contents of any suspicious fish entered in the competition. Any weight which could have reasonably been added by a competitor will result in disqualification.
- It is the angler's discretion to keep fish. All fish kept during the competition must be taken by the angler which caught the fish at the end of the weigh in period.
- All anglers must be in line to weigh fish by 2:00 PM at Gould's Landing in Orono. All anglers fish will be weighed which were in line for weigh in by 2:00 PM.
